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### Training Descriptions

| <b>Business Basics</b>  | Every day operations can be a challenge for an existing business owner or those wishing to start their own business. Learn how to write a business plan and secure startup capital through classes. Gain knowledge of demographics and regulations in your industry.   |
| <b>ITS SIDS: Infant/Toddler Safety and Sudden Infant Death Syndrome</b> | This required training explains all the parts of North Carolina’s SIDS Law. Learners will review information about when and how to use the approved waivers, how to best place a baby in bed to sleep and other “Best Practice” recommendations.   |
| <b>Creating Effective Lesson Plans</b>                                  | This class is designed to help child care providers create lesson plans that are effective and aligned with NC Foundations. The class will incorporate using the Creative Curriculum and NC Foundations to create effective lesson plans and learning environments for preschool children.   |
| <b>Emergency Preparedness</b>   | Introduces standard emergency preparedness and response procedures for child care facilities and homes, as well as, provides participants with the knowledge, resources and skills needed to instruct children in the event of an emergency. Participants will grasp the importance of being prepared for emergencies and identifying items and requirements. This is a two-part training and participants must attend both to receive credit. |
| <b>Exploring Science</b>  | This class will be a make and take class full of ideas to enhance the early childhood science center.  |
| <b>Milestones and Red Flags: Early Intervention</b>                     | Providers will learn developmental milestones for children ages birth to five as well as how to identify red flags. Also, providers learn what services and resources are available to them and how to talk with parents about developmental concerns for children in their care.  |
| <b>CPR</b>  | The Heart saver CPR Course is a course that teaches lay rescuers how to recognize and treat life-threatening emergencies, including cardiac arrest and choking for adult, child and infant victims. Students also learn to recognize the warning signs of heart attack and stroke in adults and breathing difficulties in children.  |
| <b>First Aid &amp; Safety</b>   | Child Care providers will be instructed on the basics of how to provide first aid during an emergency. The Heart Saver First Aid Course teaches rescuers to effectively recognize and treat adult emergencies in the critical first minutes until emergency medical services personnel arrive. The course also provides a complete health and safety training solution for first aid, adult, child and infant CPR.                             |
